### NOTICE OF REMOVAL OF THE NAMES OF DEFAULTING MEMBERS FROM THE INSTITUTE'S REGISTER

The Governing Council of the Institute rose from its inaugural meeting with the appreciation that the pride of membership of a professional body goes with responsibility and commitment. It therefore came up with a resolution, directing the Secretary to Council/Acting Registrar to invoke the clause in Section 6.6(c) of IPAN Act CAP. I16 LFN 2004, which states inter alia: *"It shall be the duty of the Registrar to record the names of members of the Institute who are in default for more than six months in the payment of annual subscriptions, and to take such action in relation thereto (including removal of the names of defaulters from the register) as the Council may direct or require."*

All defaulters are hereby given the grace of two (2) months, from the date of this notice, to pay their outstanding annual subscription or risk having their names published in the dailies as defaulters after which they will be de-listed.

Whosoever has his/her name de-listed would not only have to re-apply but will have to go through re-admission by writing the professional examination(s).

Every member is by this notice availed the privilege of regularizing his/her membership and have his/her name appear in IPAN Register which will be published in the dailies and circulated to all relevant Agencies, organizations and other stakeholders.

Please take advantage to avoid the embarrassment of being de-listed or having to pass through the stringent rigour of re-examination.
